





When you enter the Pathway Program, and meet the required English level, you will study in **the English for Academic Purposes (EAP)** Course. (Followed by an IELTS Preparation course if required.)

When you successfully complete the program, you will finish with the ability to write, speak and listen at a level acceptable for academic studies in Canada.




IH San Diego is proud to be the only school in the city to offer the CELTA course.
